## Scholarship Program Effective September 27, 2019

The Eastwick Foundation, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, receives generous contributions from organizations and individuals throughout the year. This allows the Foundation to award scholarships<sup>1</sup> to students at Eastwick College (Ramsey, Hackensack, and Nutley campuses) and the HoHoKus School of Trade and Technical Sciences.

To apply for the above scholarships, students must contact the Eastwick Foundation, submit an application, sign a release form, and write two essays. The Foundation will work with the campus' Department of Financial Aid to determine the student's financial need.

All Eastwick College and HoHoKus students are awarded the Eastwick Book Scholarship to cover the full cost of their books (based on the current schedule of book fees displayed on the next page). No application is necessary. Upon enrollment, the scholarship is automatically granted and credited to the student's account.
