Eastwick Elite Scholarships

Twice each year – once in the spring and once in the fall – eligible students attending Eastwick College and the HoHoKus School of Trade may apply for one of several need-based Eastwick Elite Scholarships. Eligible students must be currently enrolled and have a GPA of 3.0 or more – although a few scholarships are awarded to students with a GPA of 2.5.

The application period is announced via Eastwick Education’s social media platforms (Facebook, LinkedIn, Twitter, Instagram); flyers are also posted on Eastwick College’s Hackensack, Nutley, and Ramsey campuses and at the HoHoKus School of Trade. The application requires two essays to be submitted along with a signed Release Form.

Three weeks after the submission deadline, the scholarship winners will be announced. Their photo will be taken and they will be required to send a thank you note to one of the Founding Partners of Eastwick Elite Scholarships. The scholarship is applied to the winner’s tuition account.

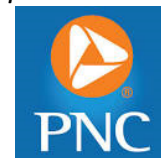
